## PARENTAL CONTROL

You can set up the PS Vita system to prevent access to games which may not be suitable for the age of a child using the PS Vita system. You should set the parental controls if you have a child who will be using the PS Vita system who is not old enough to play this or other games you have purchased for the PS Vita system. The age rating for this product appears on the packaging.

The default parental control level on the PS Vita system is 9. You will need to set the parental control level on the PS Vita system to one of 11 levels to prevent your child from accessing content which is not suitable for their age. The relationship between the age rating of a product in your region and the parental control levels on the PS Vita system is as follows:

AGE RATING	18	16	12	7	3

For example, if your child is 11 years old, you should prevent access to content which is rated as suitable for 12 years and older. In this instance, set the parental control on the PS Vita system to level 3. The lower you set the control, the more restrictive the setting. You can always change the parental control setting to allow play by older users.

In rare cases, the parental control level for this product may be more restrictive (lower) than the level which would normally apply to the age rating in your country. This is due to differences in the age rating systems in the various countries in which this product is sold. You may need to reset the parental control level on your PS Vita system to enable play of this product.

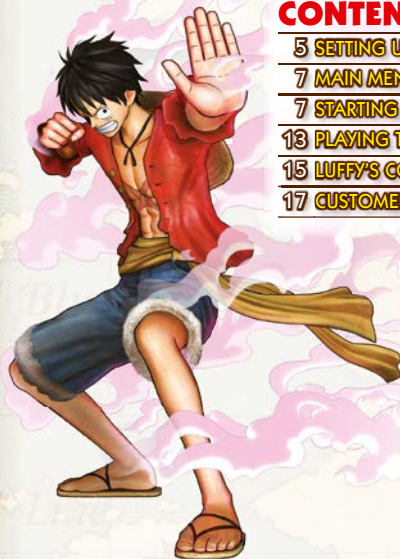

## STARTING THE GAME

### Save and Load

The game will save automatically (Auto Save) after clearing an episode. If continuing, you can choose the data you wish to load when starting the game.

You can also save your game and load previous save data from Options.

- Saving your game data requires 2048KB or more of free space.
- You can turn Auto Save After Clearing on or off in Options, Game Settings.

### Saving during battle

During a battle, you can pause the game and select Suspend/Quit from the pause menu to save your data in mid-battle.

To continue your game, select the mode you suspended from the main menu.

### Cross-Save

The PlayStation®3 system, PlayStation®4 system and PlayStation®Vita system versions of One Piece Pirate Warriors 3 can share save data. In PlayStation®Vita system version, go to Options and select Upload in Cross-Save to upload your save data to PlayStation®Network. If you download your uploaded data on the PlayStation®3 system and PlayStation®4 system versions, you will be able to continue your game on the PlayStation®3 system and PlayStation®4 system as well. You can also download the PlayStation®Vita system version's data on the PlayStation®3 system and PlayStation®4 system versions. If you turn on Automatic Update, your save data will be uploaded to the PlayStation®Network automatically every time it auto-saves.





## MAIN MENU

### Legend Log

Enjoy an adventure that follows the original series' story. You will unlock more playable characters as you progress through the game.



### Free Log

Enjoy an adventure with the character and episode of your choice.

- You will unlock more playable characters and episodes as you progress through the other modes.
- You can select this mode after clearing Legend Log's Prologue: Episode 1.

### Dream Log

Explore uncharted seas with the character of your choice. Select a route and battle enemies as you make your way to the farthest island.

- Character growth data is shared across all modes.



### Online

Connect to PlayStation® Network and enjoy co-op play with other online players. Players can also use this mode to compete for Pirate Rankings.

- You can select this mode after clearing Legend Log's Prologue: Episode 1.
- You will need a Sony Entertainment Network account in order to use PlayStation™Network features.

### Ad Hoc

In Legend Log, Free Log, and Online, you can play cooperatively with other players using Ad Hoc mode.

#### Rescue Request • Legend Log/Free Log only

If you go to Options, then Game Settings, then turn Connect to "PSN" on, you will be able to send out rescue requests to other players, and respond to ones sent by other players, while playing Legend Log and Free Log. To send a rescue request, press the START button at the episode selection screen. To answer another player's request, press the  $\Delta$  button at episodes marked with "SOS".

- You can send and answer rescue requests after clearing Legend Log's Prologue: Episode 1.
- During Online or Ad Hoc, you and the other player will share a Kizuna Gauge.

Here you can see character profiles, a glossary, listen to the game's music, and watch cutscenes. More options will be unlocked as you progress through the game. You can also unlock some options in the Bell Shop.

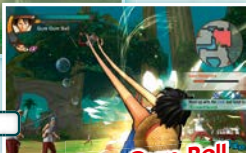
